

REGISTRATION GUIDANCE EXTENDED PRODUCER RESPONSIBILITY FOR MARKETPLACE SELLERS IN GERMANY / PACKAGING

What will change for marketplace sellers now?

As per **July 1, 2022**, marketplaces are obliged to block all accounts that do not fulfil their legal obligations for packaging.

How to fulfil my obligations as a marketplace/online seller?

1. Register with the Central Agency Packaging Register / LUCID



- Go to the registration page [LUCID](#) & complete the registration
- Before starting your registration, we recommend consulting the Central Agency's [checklist](#)
- After completing your registration, you will immediately receive a confirmation by LUCID with your registration number (DE + 13 digits)

2. Join a PRO




- Go to [Landbell's Marketplace Seller page](#) & complete the registration (your LUCID registration number/ZSVR number is requested at the bottom)
- Purchase the EASyShop contract (the contract will be activated within 24 h after receipt of payment)

3. Report your packaging quantities both to Landbell and to LUCID

Intra-year volume report

For the calendar year you can submit your intra-year volume reports, or changes of planned volume reports for the current year for past or future months within the calendar year. Please note that producers' data reports (pursuant to section 10 (3) of the LUCID Act) must be submitted by the end of the reporting period.

Please enter the volume that has undergone system participation here in kilograms to the third decimal place.

Please note the following:

- PPC stands for paper, paperboard and cardboard.
- Ferrous metals (metal alloys that contain more than 50 % ferrous metals) are taken to mean packaging that consists of more than 50 % ferrous metals.
- Aluminium (metal alloys that contain more than 50 % aluminium) is taken to mean packaging that consists of more than 50 % aluminium.
- Beverage carton packaging consists, as filling, drinks according to section 3 (2) VerpackStoffG, is a composite packaging.
- Composite packaging refers to packaging besides beverage cartons made of a combination of materials that cannot be assigned to any of the other material types.
- Other materials include, for example, natural materials such as wood and cork, textile, porcelain, stoneware and other materials.

Marketplaces are obliged to check whether your company is properly registered with LUCID. This check is done automatically by comparing the data. Therefore, it is important that the company name and the VAT number you use with your marketplace are identical to the data entered in LUCID.
